The full-time course includes more reading and writing as well as a range of options such as Film Studies, Vocabulary, New Zealand, Grammar, English for Business and Conversation. You can change your option every month.

The FCE (the First Certificate in English), CAE (the Certificate of Advanced English) and CPE (the Certificate of Proficiency in English) exams are tests of general English language ability, run by Cambridge ESOL, part of the University of Cambridge. We offer:

- 9 or 10-week full-time preparation courses, starting in January; and
- 12-week full-time preparation courses, starting in March and September.

Teacher Training - TESOL (+optional Cambridge TKT)

This is a 4-week course for non-native speakers who want to develop their teaching and language skills. The course includes input seminars on language teaching methodology, observations of experienced teachers, peer teaching and language development at a higher level. Those who do TESOL can sit the Cambridge Teaching Knowledge Test (TKT), which assesses non-native speakers' knowledge of basic language teaching concepts and methods. The TKT test takes place on the Monday after each TESOL course finishes.
